After your group selected 3 topics from the list, put them in your preference order and send it to instructor via email.

Topic will be assigned to each group on a first-come-first-serve basis.

Each group must select 3 topics (ordered by preference) from the list and send it along with your group's name to instructor via email (<u>Natawut.N@chula.ac.th</u>). Instructor will assign a topic to each group in a first-come-first-serve basis. Otherwise, the second and third topics will be considered, respectively. Instructor will reply back to the group with the assigned topic and the assigned topic will be announced on the web (same URL).

Before the deadline, submit your report in PDF file to instructor via email (<u>Natawut.N@chula.ac.th</u>). The timestamp on your email will be used to determine if your submission is on-time. As email delivery time cannot be guarantee, it is recommended to submit at least 2-3 hours before the deadline. Any submission arrived after the deadline will be penalized by deducting penalty scores from the final scores. The penalty score will be 2 points for each hour submitting late.
